Dear Student Council Advisor:

As we are completing our Homecoming events and fall activities, I would like for you to take a moment to consider whether you have a council member who is a potential IASC Executive Board candidate. It is not too early to start identifying a young leader ready to serve the IASC.

Highlights of the main duties of each office are included in the enclosed mailing. I ask that you share the information with any student who has the potential to run for an IASC office. Serving as an IASC Executive Board member is a rewarding experience for the student, the school, and you, the advisor.

According to the IASC Constitutional changes, new opportunities are available to our students. Candidates and their advisors must attend the interview meeting with the Credentials Committee on Saturday, January 28, 2012. Once these students are approved by the Credentials Committee, they will be allowed to campaign for their position. Nominations from the floor will continue to be accepted at the convention, but they will not be allowed to campaign until the interview process is completed at the convention in May.

Please remember that your school must be a member of the IASC in order to run a candidate. Membership forms are available online at www.illinoisstuco.com. In addition, all candidates must be regular voting delegates to the IASC State Convention in May and cannot serve as an Honor Delegate. If your potential candidate has applied or wishes to apply for an Honor Delegate position, he or she must contact the appropriate IASC Vice President to remove his or her application from consideration.

In November, the official IASC Executive Board applications will be available on the IASC website: www.illinoisstuco.com. However, I encourage you to begin thinking about a potential candidate now!
